



# Open Mule and Donkey Show

**Show Date: Saturday, September 13, at 1:00 pm**, Check-in time will be 8:00 am to 12:00 pm day of show.

Location: Tie Stalls in Events Center, Show in the Arena

Deadline for entry into the show, including entry fee, is August 20 at 12:00 pm

**ALL Open Mule and Donkey Show participants are responsible for being familiar with and abiding by the Livestock Rules and Regulations, along with the 2025 Rules and Regulations provided in the Fair Book. Rules and show information are subject to change without notice.**

**Required:** Animals over 6 months of age must be accompanied by an official negative test for Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins), issued within 12 months prior to the Cabarrus County Fair. Papers will be checked before show.

**Divisions:** There will not be an Open and Junior Show designation for this Show.

**No one under age 8 may participate OR enter the Show Ring with a participant at any time for ANY REASON.** No exceptions. Management has the right, without notice, to ask to view a valid birth certificate and/or ID to verify age.

**Entry Fees:** \$20.00 Per Animal/Rider Combination, unlimited number of class entries or \$8.00 per class (Due With Entry Form). The Fair does not provide refunds. No exceptions.

**Notice:** Classes may be added/deleted at the discretion of the livestock staff with Fair Management approval.

**Exhibitors may not show under someone else's name/entry for ANY reason.** Should an exhibitor enter the Show Ring under someone else's name/entry it will result in an immediate forfeiture of ALL 2025 Fair premiums and ribbons for both parties.

**This is a trailer-in only show and you will tie your mules and donkeys to tie panels in the Events Center.**
